

# Man loses foot in boating accident

IDAHO -- A man riding a Sea-Doo lost his foot when he tried to avoid crashing into a Sea-Ray.

Brynne Malone, 48, of Deer Park, Wash., was approaching the Sea-Ray when he realized he was on a collision course.

He turned hard to the left to avoid crashing with that boat, the operator of the boat turned hard to the right at the same time.

Malone was ejected from the Sea-Doo and was struck by the propeller of the Sea-Ray.

His left foot was severed above the ankle.

40-year-old Jon D. Carlson, who was driving the Sea-Ray pulled Malone from the water and called for help.

Malone was transported to Kootenai Medical Center for treatment, but his foot was not recovered from the water.

Alcohol is not believed to be a factor in the accident and no charges have been filed.
